

The Narrow River Preservation Association invites you to join in swimming on one of Rhode Island's most scenic waterways in a one-mile open-water loop swim.

DETAILS: all details available at narrowriver.org

When: Saturday, June 23, 2018, 9 a.m. (rain or shine)

Where: URI Boathouse - Campanella Rowing Center, 166 Walmsley Lane, North Kingstown, R.I.

Distance: One Mile (1/2 mile out and 1/2 mile back). Common start for wetsuit and non-wetsuit Divisions.

Timing Service: State of the art chip timing by TriMom Timing Company.

Limit: 150 participants.

Registration: Online at narrowriver.org or in person the morning of the swim



Entry Fee: \$35 if by June 21, 2018; \$40 the day of the swim. The first 125 entrants will receive a 2018 Turnaround Swim T-shirt.

Awards: Best time overall, best times for male and female swimmers in wetsuit and non-wetsuit divisions.

Check In: 7:45 to 8:40 a.m. No one will be admitted to the Turnaround Swim unless he or she has checked in and received a numbered swim cap by 8:40 a.m.

Maximum Time: Swimmers are given one hour to complete the swim.


Mandatory Safety Briefing: 8:55 a.m.

Safety: Because of the uncertainty of weather conditions such as fog or lightning, the lifeguards and event committee reserve the right to cancel the event to ensure the safety of the participants. In the event that the 2018 swim is cancelled, participants will be offered a reduced registration fee for the 2019 Turnaround Swim.

Swim Sponsors: For an additional \$15, have your name printed on the Turnaround Swim T-shirt to show your support for Narrow River.

Please note that the swim area is a natural environment, so be aware of the presence of objects that may be sharp.

Registration and Check In (green star): URI Boathouse **Start, Course and Finish (black dashed lines**): In water start at the beach adjacent to the URI boathouse dock. Swim with orange buoys on your left, round the farthest buoy counterclockwise, swim back with buoys still on your left. Finish by crossing the timing mat on shore.

Parking (noted by green line): Along Walmsley Lane facing downhill on the left. Parking is limited; carpooling is encouraged.
